

Academic Background

Reasons for not doing further study in Nepal

Since, my university degree was about to end I was thinking about higher study to increase my knowledge. Also during my bachelor degree Tribhuvan university introduced lots of subjects which was very little but very important courses that could lead any entrepreneurs to the point of success. Some of the subjects such as Entrepreneurship, Strategic Management, Organizational Behaviour, Financial management are very important to be understood by the successful managers. I feel, the content of the course during my bachelor degree is not enough up to my career plan so, to add up the incomplete knowledge I decided to continue with the relevant master degree. As compared to the foreign education system of developed countries, Nepal is still lagging behind due to the traditional educational system which is completely theoretical.

I am aiming to study such a course which has courses related to business administration as well as has specialization in Tourism and Hospitality. My innate interest in hospitality and current corporate world has led me to search for such course structure. Some of the university in Nepal are Tribhuvan University, Purbanchal University, Pokhara University, which offers MBA course of 2 years-semester based however, the content of course is mostly same curriculum with mostly based on business administration. Being a hotel management graduate I want to attain my Master's in similar field. Master of Tourism Studies and Master of Hospitality Management (MHM) are available in Nepal through NATHM (TU), and Kantipur International College provides Master of Business Administration (MBA) with focus on Business administration and Master of Hospitality Management (MHM) with only focus on Hospitality and does not incorporate business and management sector. These colleges course are only focused on a single line of studies. I prefer to learn the [course name] because these both courses are important in today's corporate world where hospitality is as its prime. Hence, I could not find suitable course to study in Nepal.

Courses have been changed and made much progress compared to past. I believe that it still lacks equivalency with education system of developed country like Australia. Education of Nepal is not qualitative as compared to foreign university education. Education system of Nepal lacks sufficient resources, technologies and has never gotten out of the basic which affects the students in terms of getting the quality education. Education is considered as a basic need in life and is highly important in this growing world to fulfill our needs and wants and also to complete with real world we need proper knowledge.

Why Not Other Countries?

Anyone who wants to get an international degree would look at the top destinations for international students. According to study portals, the top 3 destinations for international students are US, UK, Australia. I have done research on some of these countries expressing my own views.

USA:

The tuition fees and the living cost in USA is ascending day by day as the exchange rate of American Dollars is rising. I researched on Georgetown University which offered Master's in Global Hospitality Leadership with 2 years course and USD **xxxx** tuition. Similarly VATEL offered MBA with a concentration in Hospitality Management for 2 years course and USD **xxxx** per year tuition. This when converted is very expensive. In addition, one needs to appear in pre-enrollment tests like, SAT along with IELTS (International English Language Testing System) or TOEFL (Test of English as a Foreign Language) to apply in USA which is quite time consuming. Also, the crime rate is very high in USA compared to other countries making international students less safe than in other developed countries. Moreover, gun violence, frequent terrorist attacks and discrimination towards international students made me to cross out USA from my list.

UK:

I researched on different institutes in UK as Oxford Brooks University which offered MSC. International Hospitality, Events and Tourism Management for 2 years but the intake was on late September. Nottingham Trent University has MBA but taught only on Online. Completing MBA in UK course ranges from **xxxx** to **xxxx** GBP which is very expensive. The weather condition of UK is not so preferable and remains chilly cold throughout the year. The cost-of-living expenses is higher and the students may find difficulties to adjust the expenses and accommodation costs because 1 Australian Dollar is equivalent to approximately NPR **xxxx** which can vary time to time but 1 Pound Sterling is equal to NPR **xxx** making fee and the living cost too high for Nepalese.

Canada:

Some institutes I researched for my choice of course are: University of Guelph offering M.B.A Hospitality and Tourism Management with tuition of xxxx CAD. Fanshawe College offered Postgraduate Certificate in Hospitality and Tourism Operations Management with CAD xxxx tuition. When converted the expenses will be expensive. But as Australia is English Speaking Country, and I have been learning the language from my childhood and is easy to understand.

Hence, I have chosen Australia as my study destination.



I have understood all the terms and conditions and I will obey all rules and regulations of Australian government and my chosen college and remain sincere student during my whole study period in Australia.


